Description of Duties

Each representative has a vote on the QSCC Board of Governors. They are expected to attend weekly meetings to inform BOG members on the happenings of their respective student organization, or if unable to attend, submit a weekly report to BOG about those happenings.

The **CCC Representative** attends CCC meetings, held once a month. The meeting consists of representatives from each cultural center on the 2nd floor of Coffman Union. At these meetings, the CCC representative is expected to inform the other members of what the QSCC is doing the next month in terms of programming, as well as write down what other cultural centers are doing in a report.

The **MSA Representative** attends MSA meetings, held each week. The MSA representative is expected to vote on issues in a way that represents the consensus of the QSCC as a whole. They are also expected to conduct themselves with a respectful demeanor that is conducive to the business of the Undergraduate Student Body.

The **SHAC Representative** attends SHAC meetings, held once a month. They are expected to present student concerns and suggestions to the Boynton Health administrators; participate in policy formation, program review, and program development at Boynton; provide input into the formal development of the student fee request and approve its final form; prioritize health care and health education issues for students; and assists in improving and enhancing existing services and proposing new ones.
